



Lead Audio-Visual Installer Job Description

Overview:

The Lead audio-visual installer will manage contractors and other technicians focusing on performing installation, troubleshooting and configuration of audio/visual electronic equipment in residential and commercial applications.

The Lead Audio-Visual Installer will have installation experience with complex AV systems. Applicant must demonstrate experience completing technical installation and management of audiovisual systems, including equipment rack fabrication, site preparation, termination and calibration of audio and video equipment, implementation of control systems. Ability to troubleshoot complex audio, video, switching and control systems problems required. Preferred applicants should be able to discuss examples of completed projects and provide positive references. Good communication skills and customer service skills are required.

Responsibilities:

- Manage contractors and other techs to meet necessary deadlines
- Final commissioning and turnover of completed projects
- Able to wall fish moderate to complex runs, with or without insulation
- Able to address sheer wall and fire blocks in a consistent and practical way
- Able to safely install electrical receptacles, work with Romex and carries a strong understanding of electrical circuits
- Properly sets up and bills service calls and hours
- TV installation averages in under 30 minutes
- Most in wall wiring or component install averages in under 60 minutes
- CCTV system average under 70 minutes per device, able to find most practical wiring routes for custom wiring situations and cctv installations
- DirecTV job of any size average less than 3 hours(not mandatory)
- demonstrates attentive use of consumables (zip ties, wire, fittings, etc)
- Consistently arrives to jobs on time

This position also includes other duties not listed that are fundamentally relevant to the position.

- Minimum of 5 years experience in installation/commissioning of AV systems
- Experience and proficiency with common electrical hand tools including wire strippers, cutters, testers and various power tools.

- Ability to setup, test, calibrate and commission equipment and devices as required to produce fully functional systems. This includes video displays, display systems, screens, cameras, switchers, processors, transmitters, receivers, interfaces, microphones, mixers, amplifiers, controls, and other active and passive devices.
